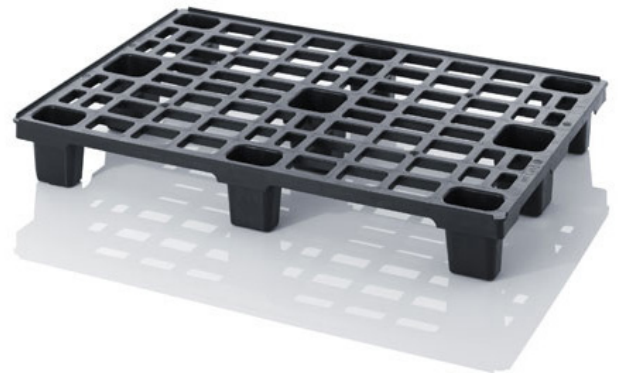

ESD lightweight pallets without skids



These lightweight pallets have an especially low empty weight. They are nevertheless durable and have an impressive load-bearing capacity and can therefore be used for worldwide exports.

The electrically conductive material they are constructed from makes them particularly suited for the storage and transportation of electronic components. They can be stacked inside each other when not in use to save space.
